“When sit-down closings do occur, the attendees have been pared down from the traditional group, and everyone in attendance wears gloves and masks. In most cases, multiple rooms are utilized, with the sellers and their attorney in one room and the buyers and their attorney in another room. The closing rooms are always disinfected pre- and post-closing, and all disposal instruments utilized during the closing process, such as pens, are thrown away or taken with each signer.”
